BULLYING; WHAT EVERYONE SHOULD KNOW

Bullying is when one child picks on another child over and over. The usual targets are children who are either smaller or weaker, are shy, cry, get mad or easily give into the other child. It usually happens when other children are watching. Bullies can be a girl or a boy. There are several types of bullying: physical, verbal and social. With the social bullying, the victim is excluded from activities or vicious rumors are started about them. Bullying occurs at school, when adults are not watching and through the internet by e-mail or instant messaging.

As a result of bullying, children who are bullied may become afraid to go to school, have complaints of headaches, stomachaches or other physical problems. They may have difficulty concentrating on their schoolwork. In the long term, these children may continue to suffer from depression, anxiety, low self-esteem and develop other mental health problems.

These children are more likely to think about suicide. Some other warning signs of bullying include:

- Damaged or missing clothing or other personal belongings
- Unexplained bruises or other injuries
- Few friends or close contacts
- Trouble sleeping or eating
- Poor school performance

Reluctance to go to school or ride the school bus

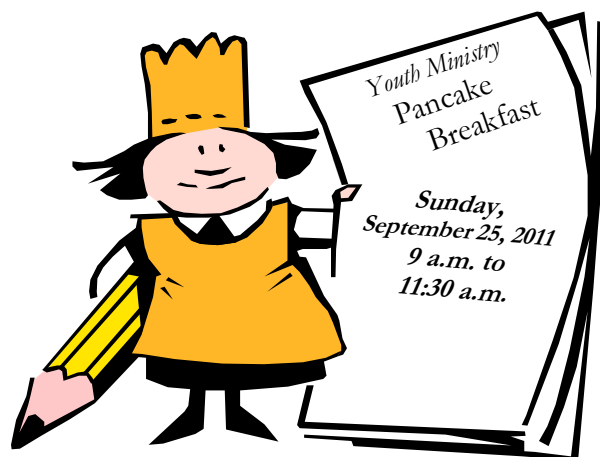

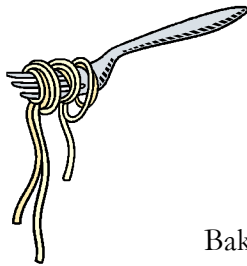
